

What should I already know?

- How to use a needle and thread.
- To use scissors to make simple cuts.
- How to hold and use scissors safely.
- Ideas are needed to create a **design**.
- How to design and make a pattern.



What new skills and knowledge will I acquire?

- You can join **fabrics** by **stitching** them together.
- The **thread** gets pushed through the hole at the top of the **needle** and then a knot can be tied so it doesn't fall out.
- A **running stitch** is a type of stitch where you keep moving the needle in and out of the fabric. This then holds the fabric together.



- A **product** must be appealing to the person it is being made for.
- You can use a **template** to draw around on your fabric and then cut out the pattern to create accurate shapes.
- You can use **glue** to attach additional **features** to your puppet, such as eyes, mouth or teeth.

product

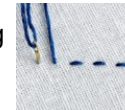
Something made by a human or a machine.
