What will I know by the end of the year?

- The name of the town I live in.
- That Flitwick is in England.
- The name of the road the school is located on.

Vocabulary

Town: A large group of houses, shops and buildings where people live and work.

Road: A piece of land which allows vehicles, people and animals to travel along to different places.

- The effects of the changing seasons on the natural world around them.
- I can describe how different types of weather can affect the local environment.

Vocabulary

Weather: The way the air and atmosphere feel. It changes regularly and it is different during each season.

Vocabulary

Globe: A model of the whole world which shows what it looks like from space.

Map: A drawing of an area shown from above. It shows the distance from one place to another.

- Look at symbols on a map.
- Show and interest in google maps and look at things from a birds eye view.
