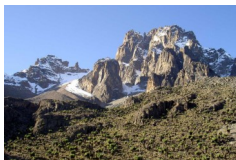

Vocabulary

game reserve	A protected area of land where humans are allowed to live and carry out some different activities.
habitat	The natural home of a plant or animal.
landscape	A large area of countryside, usually one without many buildings or other things that are not natural.
national park	A protected area of land where only tourism and research is allowed. No humans live there.
rural	Areas away from towns or cities, also known as the countryside.
safari	An expedition in which people search for animals in their natural environments.
savannah	Tropical grasslands with shrubs and trees but not much rainfall.
tribe	A group of people who live and work together in a shared geographical area.
urban	Areas where many people live and work.
