Vocabulary

Border	An imaginary line between two countries.
Continent	A continent is a large solid, body of land.
Landscape	Everything you can see when you look across an area of land including hills, rivers, buildings and trees.
Mountain Range	A group of mountains.
Ocean	Large body of salt water that covers the Earth's surface.
Region	An area of a country.
Settlement	Places where people live. They can be small or large depending on how many people live there and how many facilities there are.
Town	A town is larger than a village but smaller than a city. It has a local government.
Village	A village is a small community made up of a small number of houses and is often found in a rural part of the country.

Geographical skills and fieldwork

- Use **maps** and **atlases** to locate oceans, countries, capital cities and key geographical features such as rivers and mountains.
- Local area walk to observe and collect information about the physical and human features in Flitwick.
- Compass directions
- Use secondary sources of information (e.g. Google Earth, photographs, information texts, videos) to find out about India and Chembakolli.
